Hi, yes I will tell you my way, but it is not my single work, and I had completed that. However that is a easy and complete way...

1) Make a partition from your free space of hard disk that is recommended to be double size of ramdisk installed on your system (for example for 256mb of ram 512mb partition size recommended) for "Swap"

2) Make a partition in at least 3Gb for "root" (Clearly it is based on your used modules 5Gb is recommended)

3) Boot slax from CD or Flash Disk.

4) Use "grub.lzm" (attached to this mail) as live mode with double clicking on it (it must be in a local disk (NOT NTFS or FAT partition) location such as "Desktop" or "root") (You can also write it in slax CD or copy it into Flash Disk in this path "/slax/modules")

5) Open a Konsole and run this command: "mkfs.ext3 /dev/hda7" (or ext2) (Replace hda6 with your own root partition) then mount formatted partition ("mount /dev/hda7 /mnt/hda7")

6) Go to root partition (/mnt/hda7); Make a folder and name it "boot" and in the boot folder make another folder and name it "grub"

8) Copy "Menu.lst" (attached to this mail) to the grub folder ( path of menu.lst after copying is "/mnt/hda7/boot/grub/menu.lst"). Edit it for your own system with your favorites, but be carefull to destroy some lines.. do what you know!!! (In my case root partition is /dev/hda7 and Swap is /dev/hda6)

9) Copy "Installer.sh" (attached to this mail) to "Desktop". First edit it to match your system (change /dev name entries) and "Double Click" on it.

(For see setup progress you can go to your root partition "/mnt/hda7" and refresh content of it. However setup will complete in several minutes)

All Done! Now you can boot your system in dual boot mode with Windows and Slax!
